Warm-up and Objective Discussion				
<p>write on the board a list of words which are commonly used while traveling, make sure words with P and B because most students here in Somaliland have difficulty pronouncing the words with P as the sound P doesn't exist.</p> <p>ex.</p> <p>passport boarding ticket board abroad Price and normal common traveling words, airport, flight,</p>

<p>explain the meaning of each word and ask the students to repeat each word silently while the teacher spells the words 3 or 4 times.</p>

Make sure they pronounce it correctly.</p>

<p>Break the students up into a certain number of groups so that the quiet and loud kids are evenly distributed and so that there are 4-5 people in each group.
